SUBJECT: Presentation and/or Discussion regarding the Unfunded Projects and Funding Gap

The East Side community of voters has generously supported school modernization general obligation bond measures G, E, and I in the past twelve years. The school modernization projects completed to-date have made a positive impact in the learning environment. While that impact has made a significant difference in the lives of the students who have experienced those modernized learning facilities, there remains school facilities that have not received the benefit of modernization due to funding constraints.

Facilities planning staff identified the school modernization funding gap and have projected the impact of escalating construction costs in the foreseeable future. This information is being presented to the Board for the discussion.
