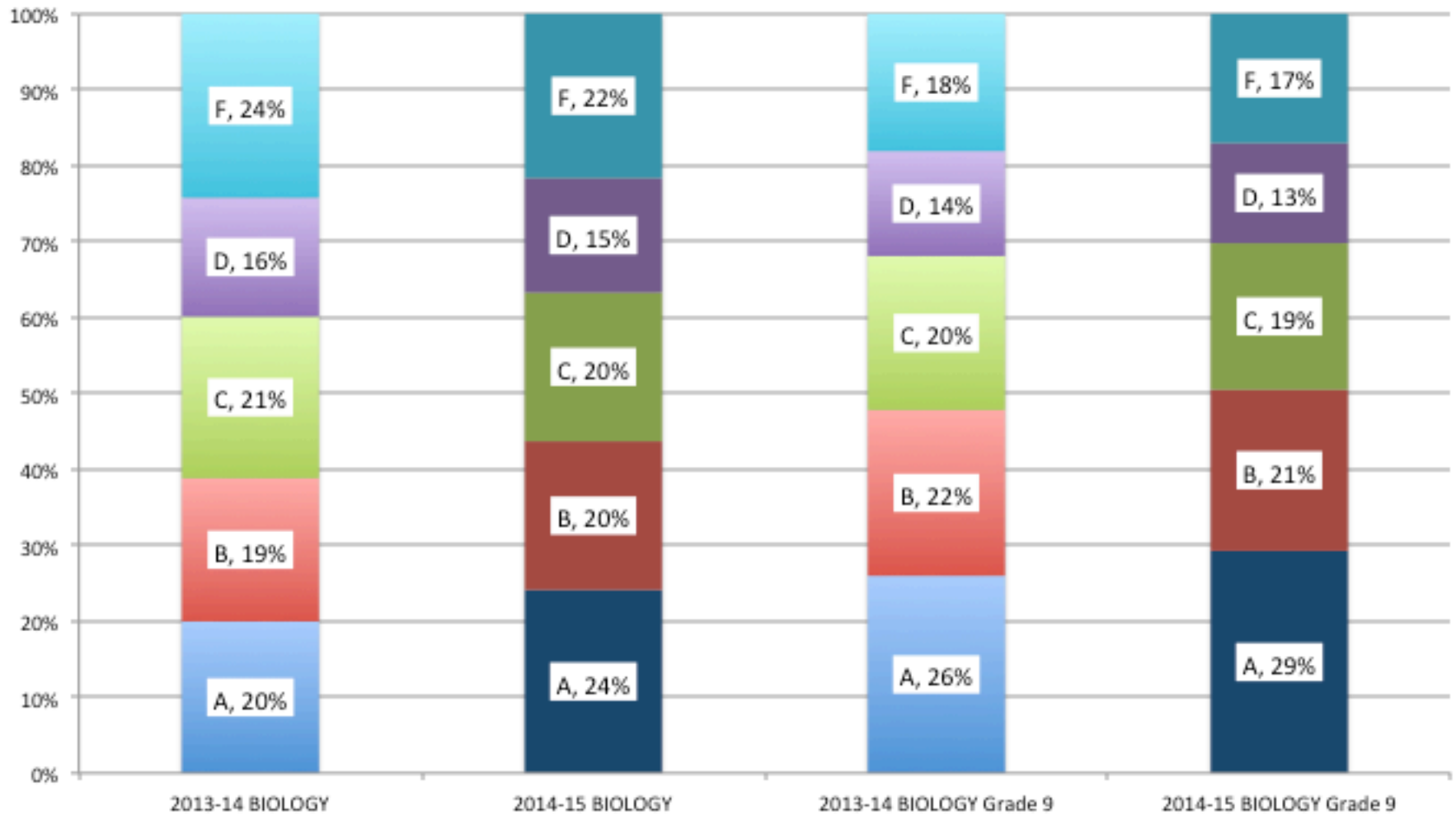

- 2014-15 Courses
 - Same courses except Algebra I
 - Disaggregated by grade level and ethnicity

2013-14 vs 2014-15 Semester 1 Grades Biology

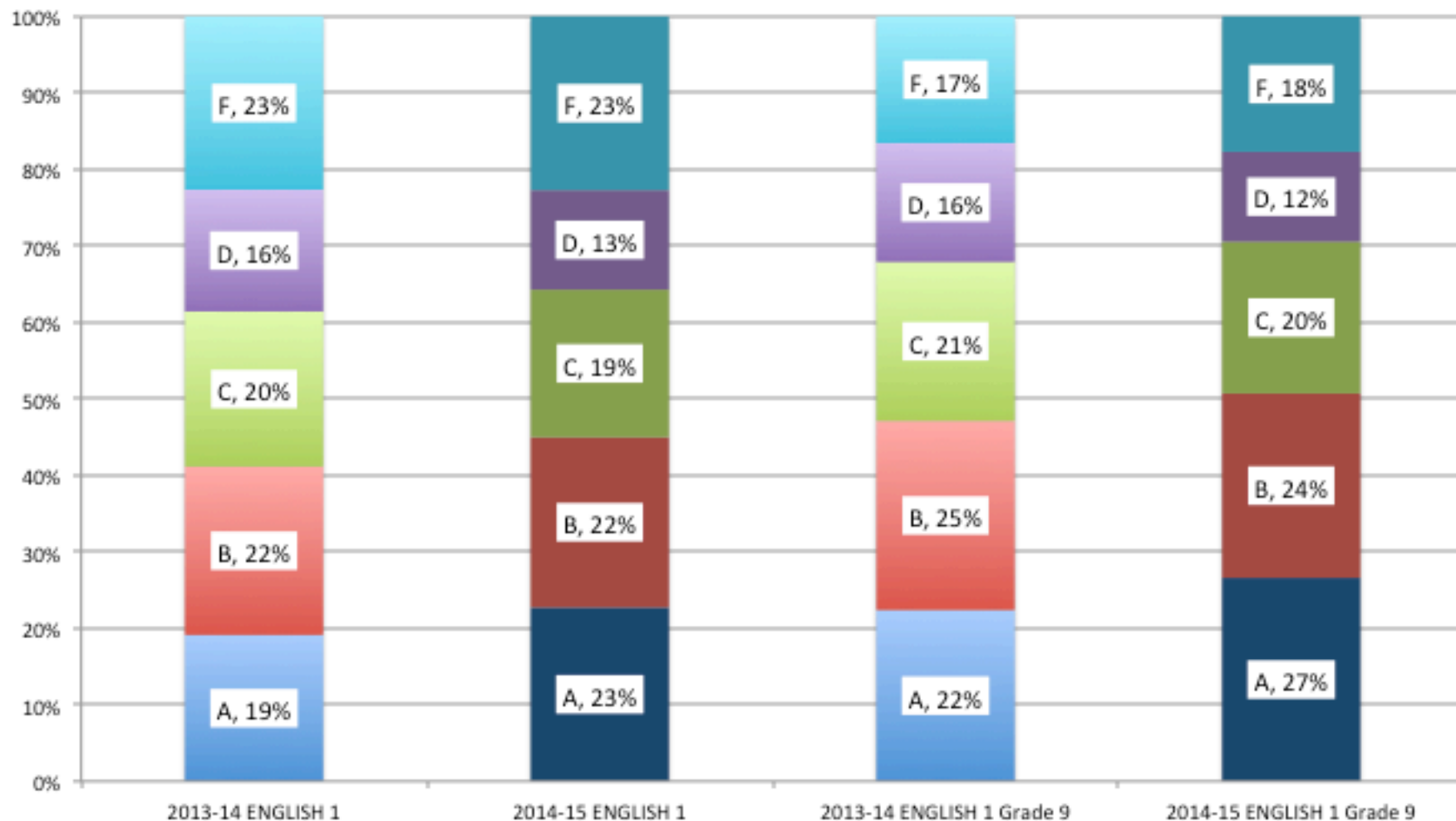

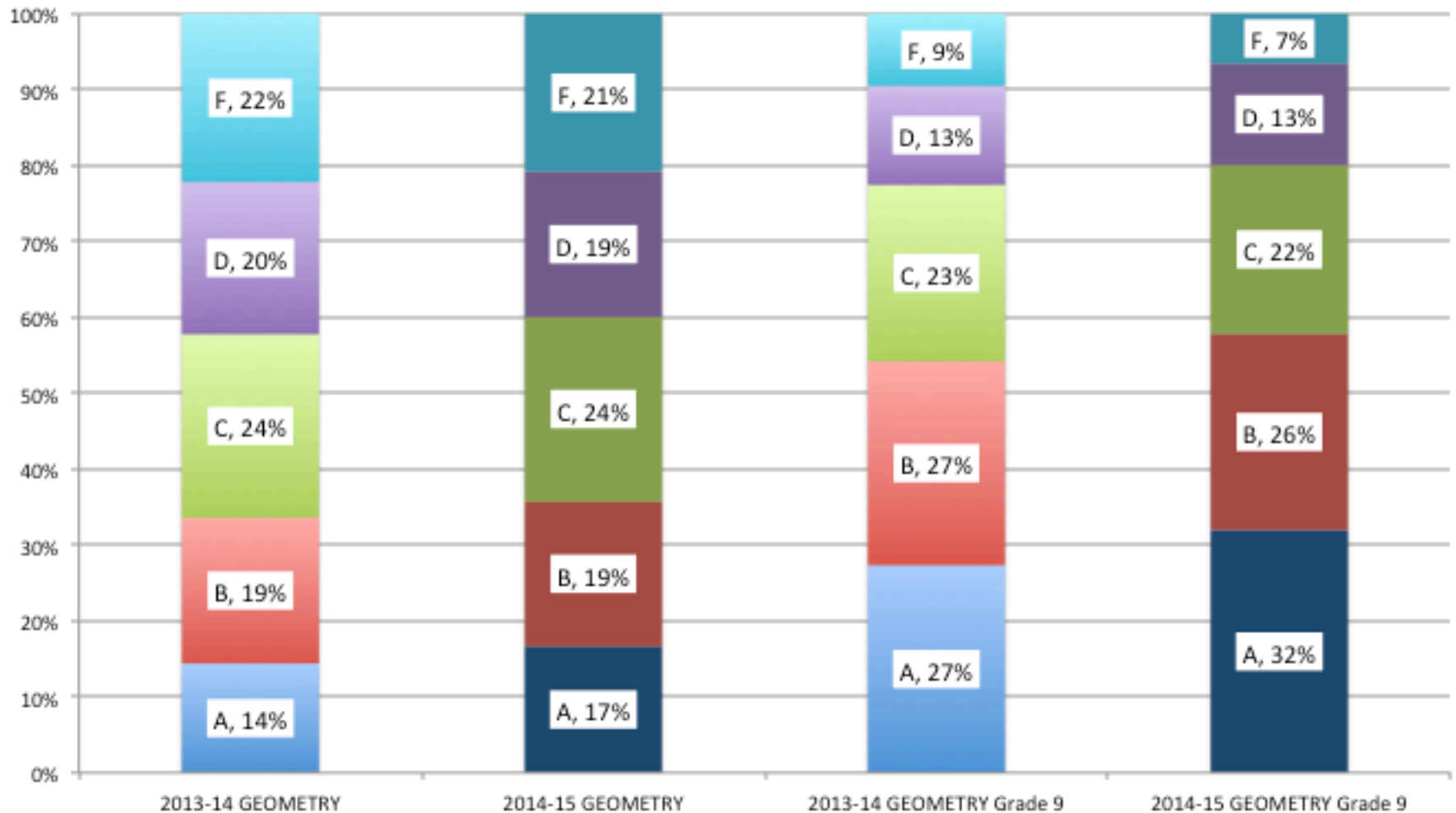

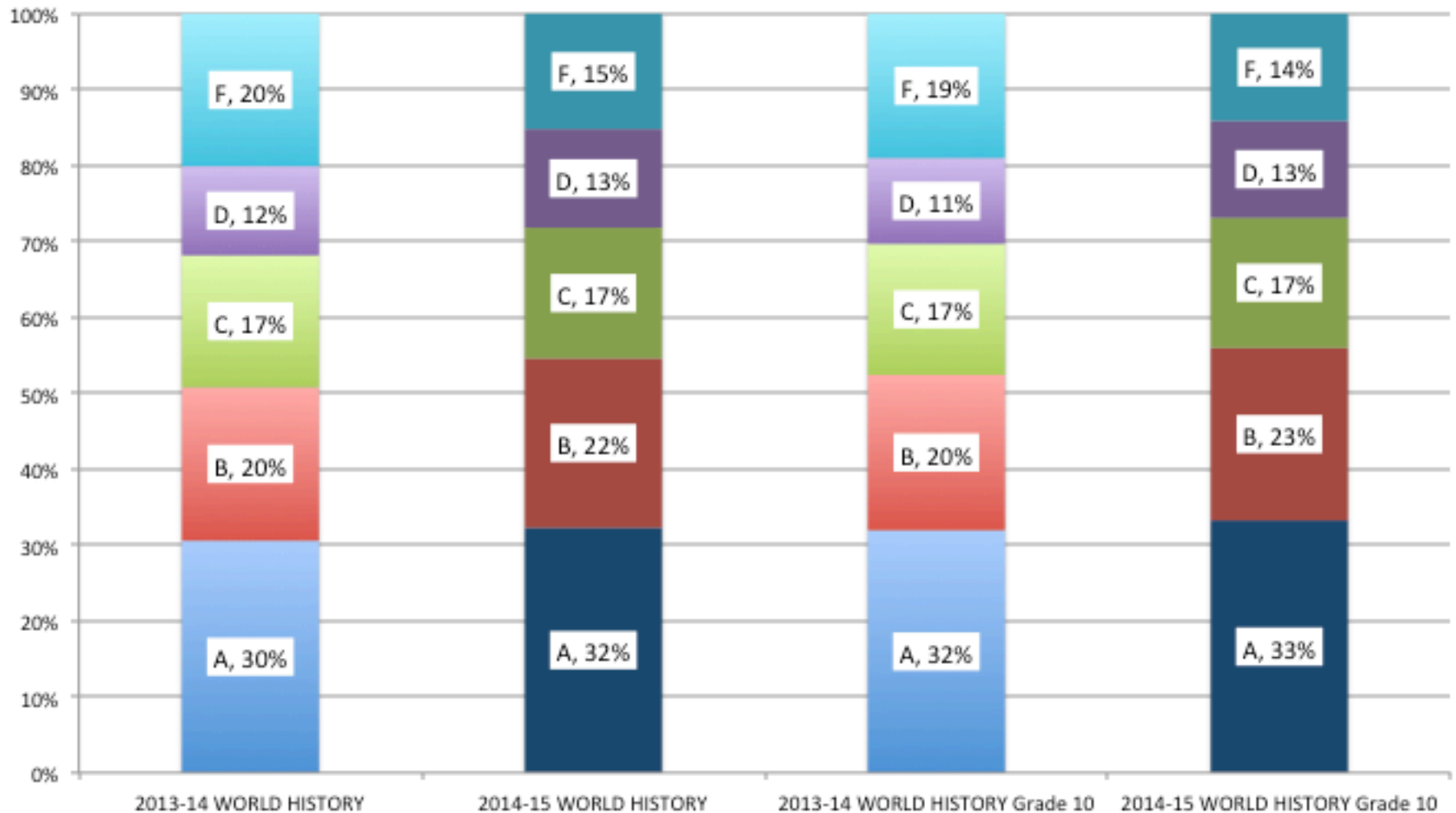

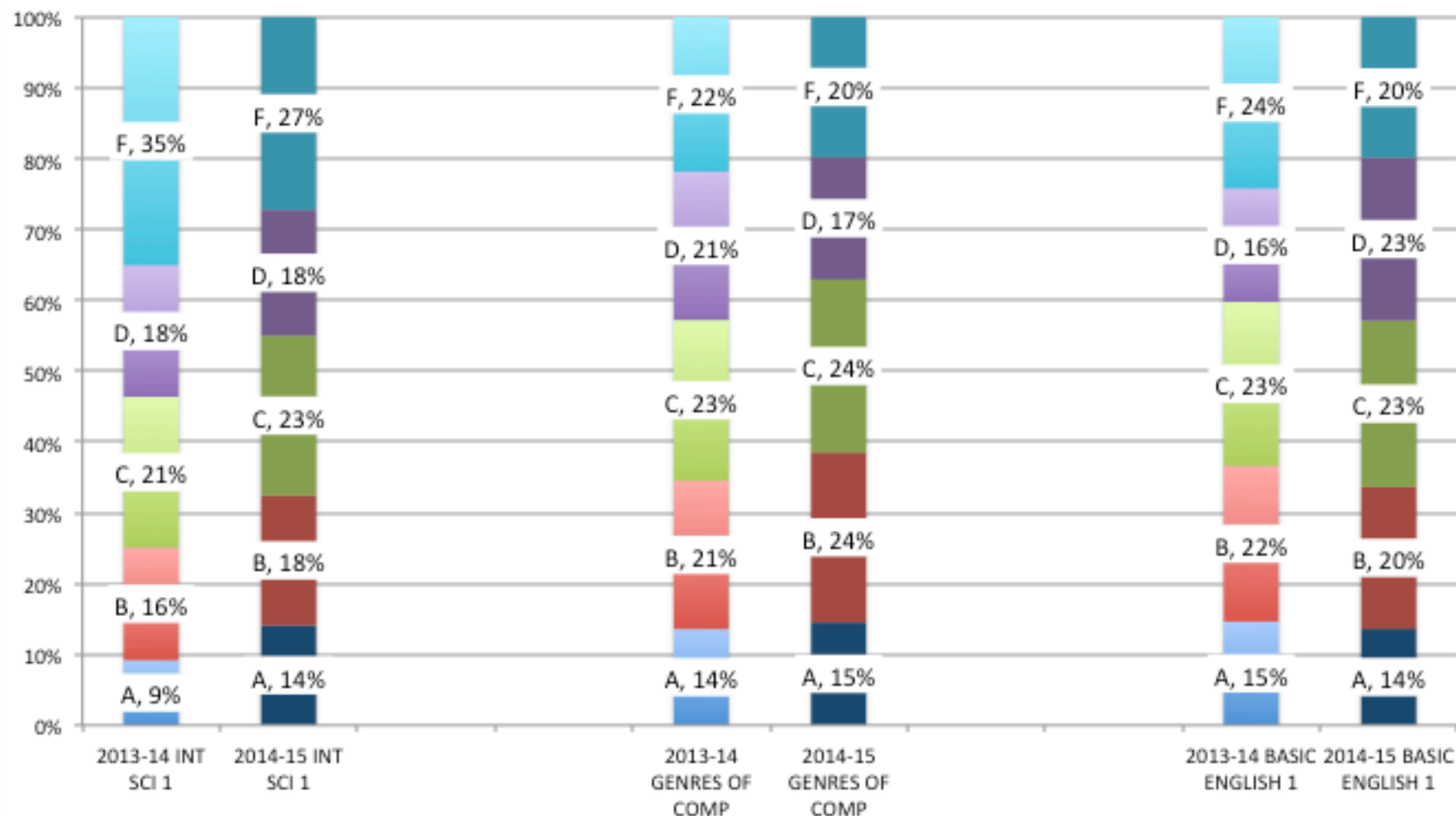
